

# JOIN US FOR A WEEKEND IN WYTHEVILLE!

Our local hosts have planned a weekend of social events for seminar attendees. Plan to arrive Thursday, June 23 and consider staying through Sunday, June 26 to explore Wytheville during its annual music and art festival!

### Thursday, June 23 – Check out Wytheville – Evening



**MEET-UP LOCATION:** Bolling Wilson Hotel Bar and Rooftop on Main Street

**DESCRIPTION:** Enjoy a lovely view of the town surrounded by mountains and overlooking the home of the “First Woman President,” Edith Bolling Wilson. Stay if you wish to enjoy dinner at Graze on Main or head out to the park for “festival food.”

### Friday, June 24 – Local brewery outing – Evening



**MEET-UP LOCATION:** Seven Sisters Brewery on Main Street

**DESCRIPTION:** Join us for a flight of craft beer, cornhole, and a trivia contest written just for local government attorneys before heading to the Elizabeth Brown Memorial Park for live music at the Chataqua Festival.

### Saturday, June 25 – River Float – Morning



Our hosts have planned a river float from Austinville to Foster Falls State.

**START TIME:** 10:30 a.m. – **MEET-UP LOCATION:** TBD

This is a short but scenic float. Put in river right off Route 636 at a new, state-of-the-art boat ramp. New River Trail State Park hugs the river here. A deep, slow pool of water under the old steel bridge is sure to harbor lunker Muskellunge and Channel Catfish. Take out at New River Trail State Park, Foster Falls Village either above Foster Falls, a Class III–IV rapid, or below it. Be sure to visit the historical Shot Tower State Park before leaving the vicinity of Jackson Ferry.

### Sunday, June 26 – Bike Ride – Morning



**MEET-UP LOCATION:** Sundog Outfitter Hiking and Biking

**DURATION:** 3-4 hours

**DISTANCE:** 1 hour drive to Damascus – 17 mile 2-3 hour bike ride mostly downhill

**DESCRIPTION:** Join participants for an early Sunday morning bike ride. Although an hour’s drive to Washington County, this is a most beautiful biking experience. Shuttle to the top of Whitetop Mountain and bike 17 miles downhill to Damascus passing over and through many bridges, rushing rivers and Christmas trees farms.
